















































Women & Girls

Pitch upgrade

ome amazing technology was on show at Priorslee Road as four new hybrid SISGrass pitches were stitched and curated by SIS Pitches ahead of the 2022 season.

This is the same technology used at a number of professional grounds around the world which combines normal turf with just five per cent of twisted compact yarn which in turn allows surfaces to become more durable with pace and bounce. This will give more playing hours and a faster recovery time than previous fully grass wickets.

A huge thanks to SIS Pitches for their work which allows us to continue to provide our members with the best quality facilities that we possibly can.

Shifnal Town Council have confirmed they will fund 75 per cent of the hybrid pitch cost – a big thank you to them! Existing club funds will be used to cover the remaining cost and we are looking forward to seeing the pitches in action.


The cost of a men's full season membership is £175 if paid by
